"Lent comes providentially to awaken us, to shake us from our lethargy." ~ Pope Francis


Lent is upon us. Each year, Lent begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on the evening of Holy Saturday, lasting 46 days if you include the Sundays. Christians observe Lent in preparation for Easter. Historically, Lent has been utilized as a period of fasting, repentance, moderation, self-denial, and spiritual discipline. 



Since the last newsletter there have been no incidents where the security of the church was threatened. At this time there are no known threats to the church or the congregation.


If you would like to volunteer and be a member of the Security Team please see any member wearing an American Flag name tag for information. If you can hold a door open and talk on a radio you are qualified.
