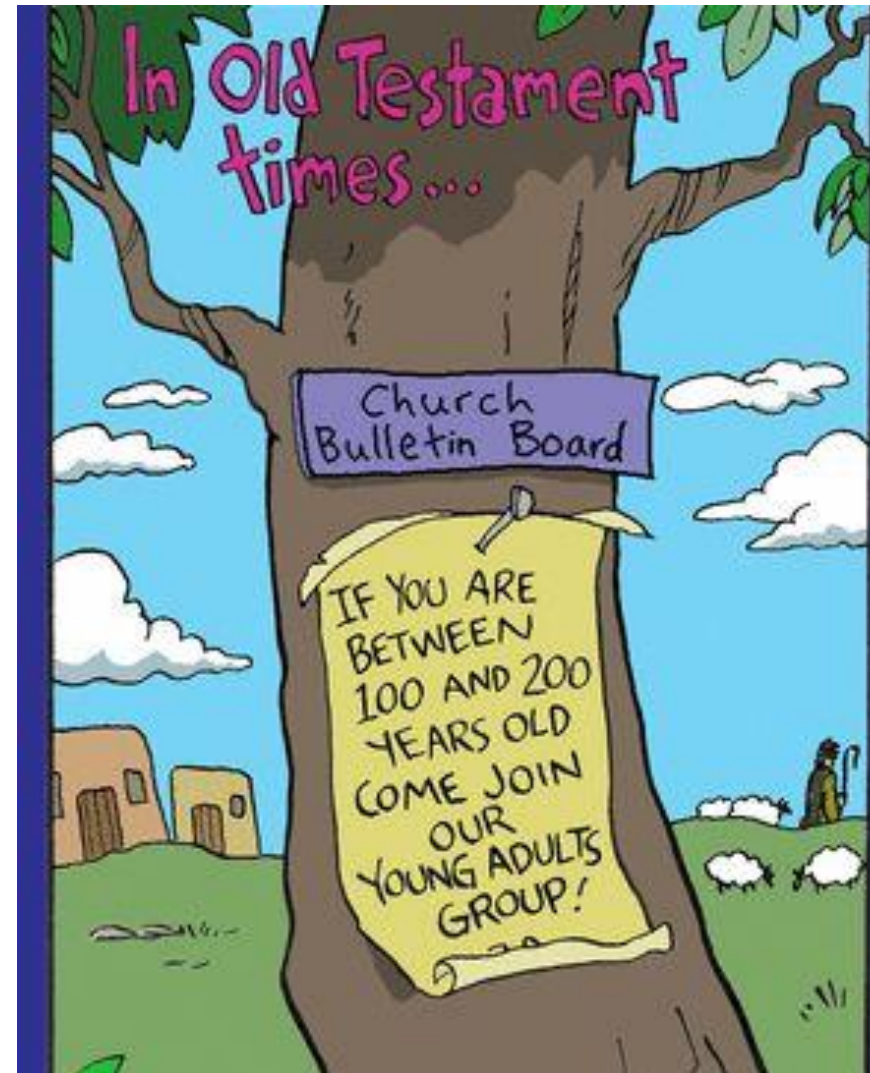

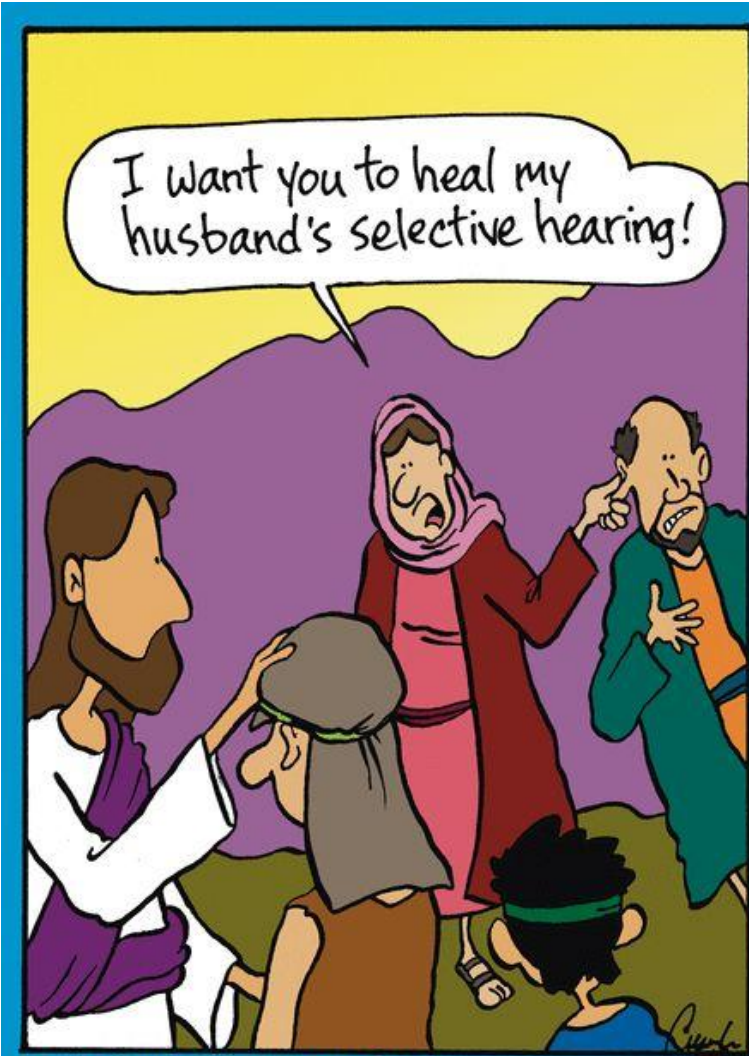


# Lake Christian Ministries Needs...
