Statement of Purpose (continued)

"The impetus stems from what seems to be a group's desire to be FREED from clerical <u>bureaucracy and the imposition of</u> <u>hierarchical authority and judgment."</u>

Seven weeks later the first service was held in rented quarters at Union Hall.
