Don Wade prepared a Statement of Purpose shared with 42 people attending a meeting to gauge interest in creating a new church.

On December 14, 1994, he said,
“Those here tonight have answered
the call to come help establish
a “PLACE OF PEACE”...

Statement of Purpose (continued)

“to help establish...a non-denominational religious environment so that each and all of us might share a peaceful haven for meditation and worship...”

Statement of Purpose (continued)

“The impetus stems from what seems to be a group’s desire to be FREED from clerical bureaucracy and the imposition of hierarchical authority and judgment.”

Seven weeks later the first service was held in rented quarters at Union Hall.
